THE BRAKEBUSH STORY



BACKGROUND

Brakebush is a poultry processing company currently operating out of 4 states and supplying up to 1 billion pounds of chicken every year. In 2007, Safety Manager Dan Ludwig was searching for a solution to reduce workplace injury and worker's compensation costs. After meeting with Dan and other Brakebush employees, it was determined their biggest issues were musculoskeletal disorders. Our goal was to implement a strategy that would maintain Brakebush employees physically and keep them safe, while getting a return on investment that would pay for the program. We created a strategy that would protect their people, improve their profitability, and give them the competitive advantage of talent retention.

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


OVERVIEW

At Brakebush in 2014, we collected data to see how much the system and collaboration was affecting their healthcare and worker's compensation costs. The results proved astonishing. the effect on Brakebush's musculoskeletal spend in both workers compensation and employee benefits was overwhelmingly positive.

Annual savings progressed from six to seven figures.
